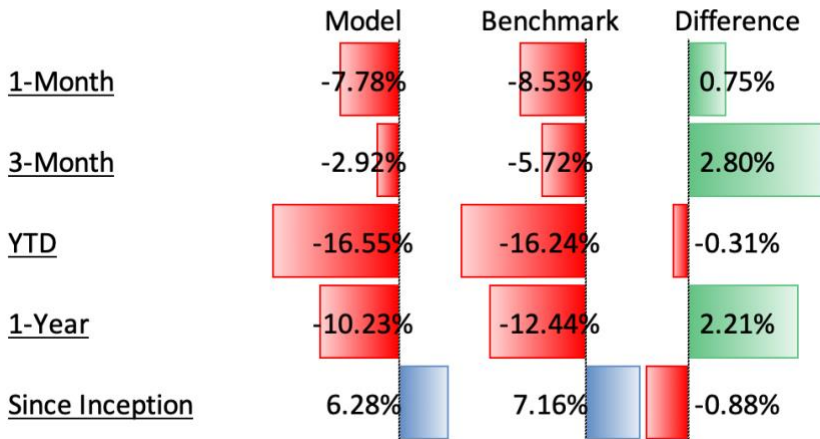


### Investment Objective & Strategy

Astoria's Inflation Sensitive Strategy targets funds that are sensitive to rising inflation, such as:

- Industrials, Materials, Agribusiness, Gold Miners, Energy, Physical Commodities (Gold & Silver), Home Construction, Financial Services, Metals and Mining, Copper Miners, and TIPS.
- Our benchmark is 70% MSCI All Country World Index, 10% Bloomberg US TIPS (1-3 Y) Index, and 20% Bloomberg Commodity Index and is rebalanced monthly.

### Trailing Net Returns<sup>1</sup>



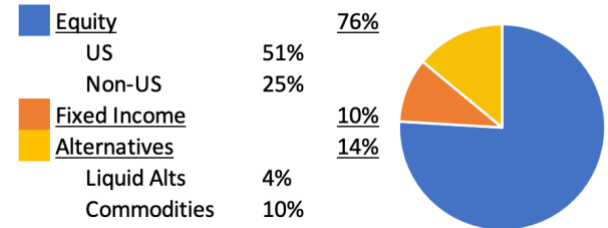

### Asset Allocation



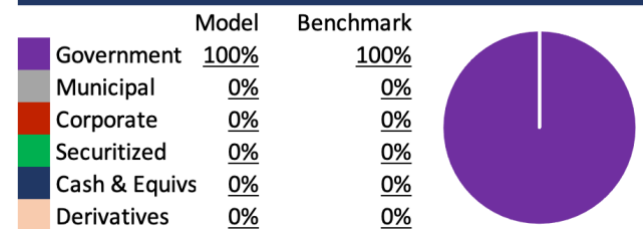

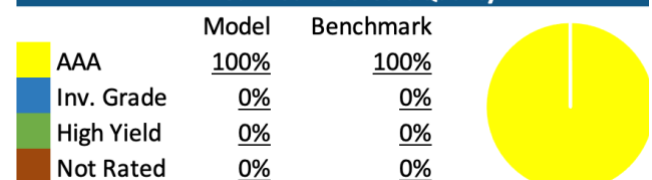

The Bloomberg US TIPS (1-3 Y) Index was chosen as it is generally well recognized as an indicator or representation of treasury inflation protected
