


Dynamic Growth & Income ETF Portfolio Fact Sheet

Investment Objective & Strategy

Astoria's Dynamic Growth & Income Strategy focuses on long term growth by blending various equity factors along with allocations to fixed income and alternatives.

It will maintain approximately 45%-55% in equities, 30%-40% in fixed income, and 10%-15% in alternatives.

Our benchmark is 50% MSCI All Country World Index (NDUEACWF) and 50% Bloomberg Barclays Global Aggregate Bond Index (LEGATRUU) and is rebalanced monthly. There is generally one or two strategic rebalances per year assuming normal market conditions.



The S&P 500 is used as a reference data set for the calculation of Beta. The Standard Deviation is calculated by Astoria Portfolio Advisors and is based on data going back to June 2017.

Prior to January 2021, the benchmark was 50% MSCI All Country World Index (NDUEACWF), 35% Bloomberg Barclays Global Aggregate Bond Index (LEGATRUU), and 15% Wilshire Liquid Alternative Multi-Strategy Index (WLIQAMST). Return Comparison: Both the MSCI All Country World Index and the Bloomberg Global Aggregate Bond indices were chosen as they are generally well recognized as an indicator or representation of the stock and bond market and include a cross section of holdings.
